ACHIEVEMENTS

Dike Repair

1. IOM completed the repair and maintenance of the primary dike in Bor town protecting the areas from floods.
2. In the emergency phase, IOM, with local youth support, repaired more than 93 broken points and contained water, saving hundreds of shelters and property.
3. In the 2nd phase of dike IOM carried out reinforcement of the dikes using heavy machinery. The phase was divided into three segments;
 - a. Construction of new secondary dikes
 - b. Major improvement on the existing dike and
 - c. Minor improvements
4. The secondary dikes were constructed in seven different areas.

Community-based Disaster Management (CBDRM)

1. After community consultations and a series of broad-based community meetings, IOM formed four Boma Disaster Management Committees (BDMC) in Bor and five in Pibor. Each committee consists of 12-15 community members, including women, youth, and older people.
2. IOM provided a two-day community-based disaster risk management (CBDRM) training to 380 individuals in Bor and Pibor
3. In Bor, IOM is constructing four community centres to provide shelter in case of flood disaster. The disaster management committees are supporting IOM in the construction of these centres.
4. As local communities are the first responders during any disaster, IOM plans to capacitate BDMCs with emergency preparedness and response kits, including the provision of canoes.
5. IOM provided multi-purpose cash assistance to 1,466 individuals affected by floods.
6. IOM in coordination with state government is installing water pump to drain rain water.
7. IOM pre positioned stock of sandbags in Bor for emergency use in case of breach to the dike
8. Following lessons learnt from Bor, IOM is working with the local communities in Pibor to upgrade and reinforced the dike.
