II. ORGANIZATIONAL CONTEXT AND SCOPE	
<p>IOM in South Sudan has a broad range of programming centred around three broad areas: humanitarian coordination and support; humanitarian response and resilience; and peacebuilding, transition, and development. Humanitarian coordination and support includes leading/co-leading the Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM) and Shelter and Non-Food Items (NFI) Clusters, Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM), Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) and management of WASH and Shelter and NFI core-pipelines, humanitarian hubs and common transport services. Humanitarian response and resilience includes CCCM, WASH, Shelter & NFI, health, protection, gender equality and inclusion, mental health and psychosocial support and the management of a Rapid Response Fund. Under peacebuilding, transition and development, IOM South Sudan implements programming on housing, land and property Page issues, transition and recovery, transhumance conflict prevention, community-based violence reduction, community development and migration management.</p> <p>Under the direct supervision of the Programme Coordinator (Transition and Recovery) and working closely with the Youth Engagement Specialist and TVET Director, the consultant will fulfill film editing tasks and more broadly, support the production of advocacy films, promoting the innovative stabilization, resilience, and peacebuilding programmes of IOM South Sudan mission. As the outcome, the consultant will contribute to the visibility of IOM’s Transition and Recovery programming in South Sudan; will produce films to be used in conferences, talks, and festivals; for internal and external educational purposes; for any other purpose, audience and media where IOM’s work will need visibility and awareness.</p>
